

Interactive Sessions

2025 Renewables in Remote Communities Conference

Prioritizing the unique opportunity to gather, conference attendees are invited to participate in a set of round-robin *Interactive Sessions*. Each session will allow for a 15-minute free flow exchange between a session host and participants (under eight participants per session) where each are invited to share project progress, network, showcase relevant technologies, and exchange questions and ideas in a structured, though casual, atmosphere. After the session has concluded, participants will be encouraged to begin a conversation with a new session host.

Industry leads, government and organizational representatives, and community leaders are all eligible to host a session but must apply to participate.

Session details:

- All sessions will be held at the Kwanlin Dün Cultural Centre.
- The sessions will be organized in "round-robin" style:
 - o Roughly 8-10 participants per session
 - o Hosts will be stationary while participants will move from session to session
 - o Each session will be 15 minutes which should be roughly comprised of:
 - Up to 5 minutes for presentation
 - 8 minutes for questions and feedback
 - 2 minutes to shift between tables
 - o There will be a signal for a table change every 15 minutes

On the day of:

- Please arrive at your session at least 15-minutes ahead of the event to organize your table and materials before it is scheduled to begin.
- Hosts will have a chance to set up before the event begins.
- Hosts are encouraged to provide supporting material (e.g. business cards, two-page handouts).

Note: Audio-visual presentations cannot be supported. Two-page printed, or electronic hand outs are thus encouraged. Please provide electronic materials to Fibha Nazim (FibhaN@pembina.org).
